## **Welcome Our New Recycling Drop-off in Lake Township!**



The Residential Drop-off Recycling Program in Wood County expanded as a site in Lake Township became the 14th location added since 2018. This new location, at 1911 Ayers

Road in Millbury, at the Lake Township Fire Station, features five bins for commingled recycling. This site accepts everything Rumpke takes, such as plastic containers, glass bottles & jars, metal cans & cups, cartons, and various paper products. There is one snag... no cardboard is accepted. This is due to the increased volume accumulated when cardboard boxes are not broken down, which fills the bins more quickly, disallowing residents to recycle other materials.

The Lake Township location is officially open to all Wood County residents. Rumpke Waste & Recycling empties the bins every Tuesday.
